Message from Mr Lucht

Welcome back to an exciting term.

This term is extremely busy with the Imbil Sports Day being held next week, our year 5 and 6 students heading off to Canberra in week 3, Gympie Eisteddfod in week 3 and then the big build up to the Mary Valley Poetry Day being held at Kandanga again this year on the 31st of August.

It is worth remembering our Target Under 500 campaign to try and keep our student absences down to under 500 for the entire school for the entire school year.
