## This funding will be used to

Develop and implement an evidence-based plan to address the specific Literacy (Reading and Writing) and Numeracy learning needs of students P-6.

### NMS (National Minimum Standards) targets:

- Year 3 – Reading and Writing 80% Numeracy 80%
- Year 5 – Reading and Writing 80% Numeracy 80%

### Prep to Year 2 program targets:

- 50% of students to achieve PM Levels aligned to NAPLAN Upper Two Bands (U2B)
  - Prep = PM Level 10 (exit level)
  - Year 1 = PM Level 19 (exit level)
  - Year 2 = PM Level 21 – 25 (exit level)
- 85% of students achieve 'C' standard exit levels
  - Prep = PM Level 7-9 (exit level)
  - Year 1 = PM Level 16 – 18 (exit level)
  - Year 2 – PM Level 21 – 25 (exit level)

### Years 3 – 6 program targets:

- 50% of students to achieve U2B in NAPLAN Writing
- 85% of students to achieve 'C' standard exit levels in Reading, Writing and Numeracy

## Our initiatives include

### Prep to Year 2:

- Embed daily one to one reading practice Prep to Year 2
- Improve and expand differentiated targeted small group instruction
- Expand explicit one to one program across both Prep and Year 1
- Continue reading intervention for at risk students
- Maintain explicit and continuous data tracking for all students

### Year 3 to Year 6:

- Formalised writing instruction program, including weekly writing tasks
- Continue with Daily Rapid Reading for all students
- Targeted reading groups
- Formalised moderation processes and access to Regional Literacy and Numeracy HOCs



## Our school will improve student outcomes by

Actions	Costs
Maintaining small class sizes to sharpen focus on individual student learning needs	<b>\$20,000</b>
Coaching teachers on benchmarks, reading assessments and reading levels by accessing Regional Head of Curriculum training days	<b>\$5000</b>
Accelerating of students below Prep to Year 2 benchmarks through extensive reading intervention programs	<b>\$3000</b>
Train teacher aides in data tracking and monitoring – training in PM benchmarking and phonics by providing professional development opportunities	<b>\$3000</b>
Train teacher aides to support explicit small group instruction using developmental programs	Internally managed
Train volunteers and teacher aides to support One to One Program in Prep and Year 1	Internally managed
Planning and implementing buddy reading programs	Internally managed



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
