Cross Country

Our School Cross Country was postponed due to student illness and we have set a date for the 2nd week back next term.

There are separate races and distance for each year level up to grade 4, for students turning 10, 11 or 12 this year they will run in their age group regardless of their year level. This is to fit in with the upcoming district trials for cross country that will be held in Gympie in the first week of May. For our age group students to earn a place at the district trials, they must complete their full race distance (2km for 10 year old and 3km for 11-12 year old) and finish under a set target time. For 10 year old this time is 10 minutes for boys and 12 minutes for girls, for 11 and 12 year old the qualifying time is 15 minutes for boys and 18 minutes for girls.

Those students that are not competing for places or district trial positions have the option to complete a shorter participation based distance.

More info will be sent out to parents early next term.

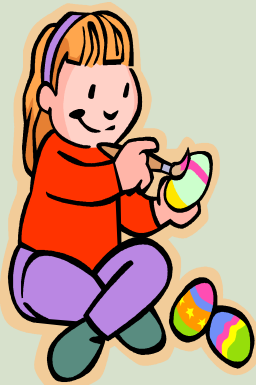
